We at Royal Blue Traders work our hardest to ensure that you are satisfied with your purchase of authentic historical clothing. Therefore, if after trying it on, the fit is not to your liking, please contact us so that we can make adjustments as necessary.

Although making an individual garment does not take long, making your particular garment may take long. We complete orders on a first come, first serve basis. If there is a problem when the garment comes to you, we will try our best to get that problem fixed as soon as we can.

The total bill is based upon cost of materials, labour involved, and any shipping costs. Payment is half up front, and half on shipment/handoff. Prices are set in stone, we are up front with them and will not change them mid-stream, please do not try to bargain us down.

Materials include things like buttons, facing fabric, interfacing, lining, regimental laces, hooks and eyes, etc. If any of these are provided, they will of course be deducted from the material cost; everything else will be added to the bill.

The labour charge is dependent upon how much machine sewing has been done, and how much hand sewing has been done. Machine labour is less expensive, but it is less historically accurate.

Shipping charges are whatever the carrier charges me, plus \$4 for my time getting it to the carrier. A standard frock coat can fit in a USPS \$12.40 flat rate box, so the total cost for shipping would be \$16.40

As a tailor I do prefer to measure you, the customer, myself, as well as meet for a fitting. If there is a problem with the fitting or my measurements, then payment can be stalled until the problem is fixed. If measurements have been sent to us by any other means, we make the garment to those measurements and we expect payment when we ship the garment to you, and not after any alterations.
